



## 2011-2012 Badger Region Volleyball Junior Membership Options

*These fees are for Badger Region/USA Volleyball membership. Additional tryout fees and club fees will apply.  
Questions regarding club fees should be directed to the individual club. There will be NO REFUNDS on any membership.*

### Full Junior Membership

\$47 (Sept. 1, 2011 - Oct. 31, 2012)

For boys and girls players up to age 18. This is a full-year membership that is required for regional and national competition. Membership benefits also include USAV secondary insurance coverage, the USAV member magazine and access to Regional and National High Performance programs. ### Tryout Membership

\$10 (Nov. 1, 2011 - Nov. 30, 2011)

For boys and girls players up to age 18. This is a limited membership that is good ONLY for five tryout dates between Nov. 1 and Nov. 30. This is an ideal option for those who have never played club volleyball before or are unsure if they will participate for the entire season. Players MUST upgrade to participate in practices and tournaments with a club team.

### One-Event Membership

\$10 (One Event, One Date Only)

For boys and girls players up to age 18. This is a membership option that is limited to one participation date and event only (i.e. a tune-up clinic) and includes USAV insurance coverage. This membership is invalid for tryouts, practices and tournaments. Players who will participate in more than one tune-up clinic prior to a club season must purchase multiple one-event memberships if they choose not to become a full member. The date of the event must be included when purchasing.

### Upgrade Membership

\$37 (Nov. 2011 - Oct. 31, 2012)

For boys and girls players up to age 18. Available to players who have already purchased a one-event or tryout membership and will participate for the entire club season in regional or national competition. Member benefits include all listed under a full membership.

### Youth Membership – Ages 9-11

\$15 (Sept. 1, 2011 - Oct. 31, 2012)

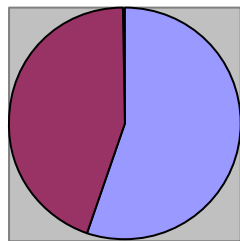
For boys and girls players ages 9-11 for recreational play only. Includes USAV insurance and member magazine. If a player will participate on a junior roster, there is an upgrade available to a full junior membership for \$32.

### Youth Membership – Ages 8 & Under

FREE (Sept. 1, 2011 - Oct. 31, 2012)

For boys and girls players up to age 8 for recreational play only. If a player will participate on a junior roster, there is an upgrade available to a full junior membership for \$47.

## 2011-2012 Badger Region Volleyball Adult Membership Options

*These fees are for Badger Region/USA Volleyball membership. There will be NO REFUNDS on any membership.  
Junior club coaches should contact their club director to see policy on who (club or coach) pays for the membership.*

### Full Adult Membership \$50 (Sept. 1, 2011 - Oct. 31, 2012)

This is a full-year membership for all officials, players and those associated with a junior club (directors, coaches, tournament directors, board members). An additional \$18 background screening fee will be required if you will have contact with juniors and do not have an updated screen in the system. Membership benefits also include USAV insurance coverage, the USAV member magazine and access to all Regional and National tournaments and events. ### Collegiate Membership \$25 (Sept. 1, 2011 - Oct. 31, 2012)

Full-year membership for college-age members ONLY who will be playing, officiating or coaching. Proof of enrollment in college can be requested at any time or membership will be suspended. Those members associated with juniors (coaches or officials) must also complete a background screen for \$18 if there is not a current screen in the system. Member benefits include all of those listed under a full adult membership.

### One-Event Membership \$10 (One Event Only)

For all adults 18 and over for PLAYING in one event. This membership is not valid for anything regarding junior volleyball (i.e. coaching) or officiating. This is a membership option that is limited to one event only (i.e. a two-day tournament) and includes USAV insurance coverage. Players who will participate in more than one event must purchase multiple one-event memberships if they choose not to become a full member. Not valid for USAV Adult Nationals.

### Upgrade Membership \$40 (through Oct. 31, 2012)

Available to players who have already purchased a one-event membership and will participate for the rest of the season, including USAV Adult Nationals. Member benefits include all of those listed under a full adult membership.

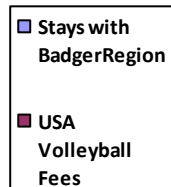
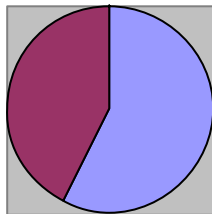
### Chaperone Membership \$25 (Sept. 1, 2011 - Oct. 31, 2012)

For team chaperones only, not for coaching or any other role. Minimum age is 25 and member benefits include all of those listed under a full adult membership. A background screen must also be completed for \$18 if not on file.

### Summer Membership \$15 (May 1, 2012 – Oct. 31, 2012)

Available to adult players from May 1, 2012 to Oct. 31, 2012 who have not already purchased a full adult membership. Includes USAV insurance.

#### **Where does the Full Adult Membership Money Go?**



\*\$28.65 of the \$50.00 stays with the Badger Region to help pay for coaching and officials education, training, supplies and clinics as well as Region management/administration (staff, office, supplies, meetings), membership services and promotion of the sport of volleyball.

\* \$21.35 of the \$50.00 goes to the USA Volleyball National office to help pay for sport accident and liability insurance, coaching and officials education, training

and development of support materials provided to the Regions as well as sport development and promotion, national database and membership services, and the National management (staff, office, etc), which we rely on as the backbone of our Region.
